PER CURIAM:

Robert Ratliff, Esq., appointed counsel for Richard Nava, has filed a motion

to withdraw on appeal supported by a brief prepared pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967).
