PER CURIAM:

Christopher N. Patterson, appointed counsel for John Q. Durfey in this direct criminal appeal, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct.
