PER CURIAM:

Rick D. Collum, appointed counsel for Harold Clinton Lasseter, has filed a

motion to withdraw on appeal supported by a brief prepared pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct. Because independent examination reveals no issues of arguable merit, counsel's motion to withdrawn is **GRANTED** and Lasseter's sentence is **AFFIRMED**.
