PER CURIAM:

Peter Warren Kenny, appointed counsel for Donald Mitchell in this appeal

of the revocation of Mitchell's supervised release and subsequent sentence, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct. Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no arguable issues of merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**, and the revocation of Mitchell's supervised release and subsequent sentence are **AFFIRMED**.
