Following oral argument in this appeal, we entered a Limited Remand Order remanding this case to the district court for the purpose of deciding whether this case

is moot because of the October 6, 2008, amendment (effective after the action was filed) to the regulation at issue. The district court has now entered an order, consented to by all parties, finding the action moot.
