This is an appeal from the January 16, 2008, final order of the district court that entered judgment following a bench trial. The judgment ordered the foreclosure of a Fort Lauderdale condominium to satisfy delinquent tax liabilities of taxpayer William Dornbrock. Intelec, Inc. intervened in the case claiming that it owns the condominium at issue.
