PER CURIAM:

James A. Hernandez, appointed counsel for Gregorio Delgado-Benitez in
this direct criminal appeal has moved to withdraw from further representation of

the appellant, because, in his opinion, the appeal is without merit. Counsel has filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967).
