PER CURIAM:

Maurice C. Grant, II, appointed counsel for J. H. Hardy in this appeal, has

moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and has filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967).
