Kristen Gartman Rogers, appointed counsel for Rodney Desmond Martin in
this revocation of supervised release proceeding has moved to withdraw from

further representation of the appellant, because, in her opinion, the appeal is without merit. Counsel has filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct.
