PER CURIAM:

Faith Mesnekoff, appointed counsel for Miguel Paniagua-Munoz, has filed a

motion to withdraw on appeal supported by a brief prepared pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967).
