PER CURIAM:

Thomas Wooldridge, appointed counsel for Angel Resendiz in this direct criminal appeal, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct.
