PER CURIAM:

Adeel Bashir, appointed counsel for Elias Morales in this direct criminal appeal of the revocation of Morales's supervised release, has moved to withdraw

from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct.

Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no arguable issues of merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**, and Morales's revocation and sentence are **AFFIRMED**.
