PER CURIAM:

Jared Westbrook, appointed counsel for Jeffery White in this non-direct criminal appeal, has moved to withdraw from further representation of White and

filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that Westbrook's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct. Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no arguable issues of merit, Westbrook's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**, and the district court's denial of White's motion for relief under the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, § 404(b), 132 Stat. 5194, 5222 is **AFFIRMED**.
