Stephen Langs, appointed counsel for Victor Armendariz in this appeal of the revocation of Armendariz's supervised release and sentence imposed upon revocation, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct.
