Thomas B. Walsh, appointed counsel for Tony Collier in this direct criminal appeal, has moved to withdraw from representing Collier, supported by a brief prepared under *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct.
