Before JORDAN, NEWSOM, and BRASHER, Circuit Judges. PER CURIAM:

Patricia Kyle, counsel for Jacnely Morejon in this direct criminal appeal, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct.
