Domingo Soto, appointed counsel for Deri Hobbs in this appeal following the revocation of Hobbs's supervised release and resentencing in 2022, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct. Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no arguable issues of merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**, and the revocation of Hobbs's supervised release and the imposition of a new sentence of 60 months of imprisonment are **AFFIRMED**.
