PER CURIAM:

The Government’s motion to dismiss this appeal pursuant to the appeal waiver in Appellant’s plea agreement is **GRANTED**. See *United States v. Bushert*, 997 F.2d 1343, 1351 (11th Cir. 1993) (sentence appeal waiver will be enforced if it was made knowingly and voluntarily); *United States v. Boyd*, 975 F.3d 1185, 1192 (11th Cir. 2020) (sentence appeal waiver will be enforced where “it was clearly conveyed to the defendant that he was giving up his right to appeal under *most* circumstances” (quotation marks and brackets omitted)); *United States v. Weaver*, 275 F.3d 1320, 1333 (11th Cir. 2001) (an appeal waiver is enforceable when the waiver was referenced during the plea colloquy and the defendant confirmed that he understood the provision and had entered into it freely and voluntarily); *United States v. Medlock*, 12 F.3d 185, 187 (11th Cir. 1994) (there is a strong presumption the defendant’s statements during a plea colloquy are true).
