This appeal is DISMISSED, *sua sponte*, for lack of jurisdiction. The 60-day statutory time limit required Angela McGruder to file a notice of appeal from the district court's May 4, 2023 final order and judgment on or before July 3, 2023. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2107(b); Fed.
