PER CURIAM:

The Government's motion to dismiss this appeal pursuant to the appeal waiver in Arthur's plea agreement is GRANTED. *See*

United States v. Bushert, 997 F.2d 1343, 1351 (11th Cir. 1993) (sentence appeal waiver will be enforced if it was made knowingly and voluntarily); *United States v. Boyd*, 975 F.3d 1185, 1192 (11th Cir. 2020) (sentence appeal waiver will be enforced where “it was clearly conveyed to the defendant that he was giving up his right to appeal under *most* circumstances” (alterations adopted, emphasis in original)); *United States v. Hunter*, 146 S. Ct. 1702, 1713 (2026) (appeal waivers can be set aside due to a miscarriage of justice “only if the sentence is marred by the kind of egregious error that would bring the judicial system into disrepute”).
