PER CURIAM:

The Government's motion to dismiss this appeal pursuant to the appeal waiver in Burch's plea agreement is GRANTED, and we DISMISS with prejudice his challenges to his sentence. *See*

United States v. Bushert, 997 F.2d 1343, 1350-51 (11th Cir. 1993) (holding that a sentence-appeal waiver will be enforced if it was made knowingly and voluntarily); *United States v. Grinard-Henry*, 399 F.3d 1294, 1296 (11th Cir. 2005) (concluding that the waiver of the right to appeal includes the waiver of the right to appeal difficult or debatable legal issues or even blatant error).
