PER CURIAM:

Mark Rodriguez, appointed counsel for Tina Culkin in this appeal from her conviction and sentence for conspiracy to distribute five or more kilograms of cocaine, in violation of 21 U.S.C.

§§ 841(b)(1)(A), 846, has moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant and filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct. Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no arguable issues of merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**, and Culkin's conviction and sentence are **AFFIRMED**.
